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Principal's Report

Dear Parents and Friends,

2026 Planning

At this time of the year, many decisions and arrangements are being made in preparation for the 2026 school year. To assist in our planning, we would appreciate being notified immediately of any the following situations. New enrolments (2026 Preps and other levels) - if you know of any new enrolments, please notify the office. Moving away - if you are not returning to us in 2026 (Grade 6 excluded), please notify the office of your impending departure or feel free to arrange a meeting with me. If you have any specific concerns around grade transition to 2026, please notify me in writing/email or again arrange a meeting, no later than the 4th of December. Whilst there are no guarantees, reasonable concerns will be considered.

We currently have 280 students enrolled at the school which is 8 more than at census time at the start of the year and we are currently planning on 273 students being here at the start of 2026.

In planning for 2026 we at this stage aim to have the same number of grades supported by the same 6 specialist sessions, 9 educational support staff and one more teacher that will continue to be wellbeing focused.

Emergency Evacuation/Lock Down

Over the next two weeks we are planning some Safety Drills in the school. The whole process should take no more than 30 minutes and is part of normal OHS and Emergency Management planning prior to summer.

Swimming Program

Thanks to the parents who have returned notes and payment for the swimming program starting next Monday. Dates were

finalised on Tuesday with South Gippsland Shire, after the pool was unavailable for use last year. Even though it is a 5-session program we have heavily subsidised the program with Sporting Schools funding and Department of Education funding. As we know swimming lessons prior to summer are vitally important for children to start thinking of the dangers around water.

Last Friday Bendan Lee worked with all our staff focusing on the science of learning and delivering effective teaching practices. It has been some time since we last had school wide professional development and he was well received by our staff. Coming from Sydney and working with schools around Australia, Brendan had two days with our school, firstly visiting grades and observing Teachers on the Thursday then giving feedback to staff as part of the professional development day on Friday. In grades throughout 2026 ww will be working on some of his suggestions and again having Brendan back with us through the year.

We look forward to our camps next week. Our grade 6's are heading to Wilson's Promontory on Tuesday until Thursday and our 2's head off on their first camp to Inverloch. Both are fantastic camps with the 6's finishing their camps at MNPS with the best one last of all. Thank you to the parents volunteering and to our staff for organising and running them.
